The Romani Studies Program (RSP) is an academic unit at CEU, encompassing the Advanced Certificate in Romani Studies Program and the Roma Graduate Preparation Program (RGPP).

RGPP* is an intensive, 10-month, non-degree program that prepares Roma students to compete for merit-based places in English-language master's degree programs. 85% of our graduates have been accepted to master's programs.

The RGPP selection criteria includes: openly declaring oneself as Roma, citizenship of any European country (Turkey included), completed bachelor's studies by June 2022, intermediate (B1) English language skills, as well as strong interest in studying at graduate university level in an international environment.
